16. During an office inspection, the supervisor notices sparks coming from a power socket and several computers connected through damaged extension cords. Based on this situation, mention any two common causes of electrical hazards. (2)

17. Case Study (4)

Ishita is preparing the Annual Cultural Fest Brochure in LibreOffice Writer. She wants the document to appear professional and well-organized. During the design process, she faces the following issues:

- The table of contents is not appearing even after inserting it.
- The event titles are typed manually instead of using proper heading styles.
- She wants the table of contents to update automatically when new sections are added.
- The Principal wants each heading to follow the same style and font format.

- (a) Why is the table of contents appearing empty even after Ishita inserts it?
- (b) Which step should she follow to make the table of contents update automatically after editing the document?
- (c) Which feature should Ishita use to ensure all headings have a uniform appearance?
- (d) From which menu option can she insert the table of contents in LibreOffice Writer?

 - (b) As a database administrator, you need to ensure each student has a unique identifier. Which field in the table would you choose as the primary key?
 - (c) Identify the field that can serve as an alternate key.
 - (d) How many records and fields are present in the given table?
19. Repetitive Strain Injury (RSI) affects the hands, wrists and arms of computer users who perform the same movements for long hours, such as typing or using a mouse. These problems occur due to poor workstation setup or lack of breaks. List any four ways to prevent this problem. (4)
20. Amit is maintaining an Inventory Management Database in LibreOffice Base. He has two tables—ProductCategory (master table) and Products (transaction table). (4)
- The ProductCategory table stores information like CategoryID and CategoryName.
 - The Products table includes ProductID, ProductName and CategoryID as a foreign key referring to the ProductCategory table.
- Amit wants to ensure consistency between both tables while performing update and delete operations.
- (a) What is referential integrity? Give an example from Amit's database.
 - (b) Amit wants to stop deletion of a category that is already being used in the Products table. Which option should he select?
 - (c) If a CategoryID is modified in the ProductCategory table, how does the **Update Cascade** option affect the Products table? Give an example.
 - (d) If the **Set NULL** option is used and a master record is deleted, what happens in the Products table? How is it different from **Set Default**?
21. Mr. Karan, Accountant of Bright Traders, has recorded monthly sales data in different worksheets in Calc. He wants to prepare a summary and total sales. (4)
- (a) Which tool can he use to combine data?
 - (b) Name the menu and sub-menu option.
 - (c) Which function gives total sales?
 - (d) How can he create a hyperlink to open a report?
