### Chapter 8. Verbs: Active and Passive Voice

**Exercise 1**. Read this simple method of preparing a delicious and nourishing vegetable stew.

## Vegetable Stew Ingredients

### 115 gm potatoes115 gm tomatoes

115 gm carrots

100 gm beans

100 gm onions

5 green chillies

1/2 tsp ginger paste

1/2 tsp garlic paste

1/2 coconut

1/2 bunch coriander leaves

2 tsp oil Salt to taste

#### Method

Wash and cut the vegetables. Slice the onions and green chillies. Grate the coconut and extract one cup first milk and one cup second milk.

Heat the oil, add the onions and green chillies and fry till onions are transparent. Add ginger and garlic paste, vegetables and salt. Fry for a few seconds, then add the second milk and cook till the vegetables are done. Add the first milk, simmer for a while and remove from the fire. Add coriander leaves as garnish. Serve with boiled rice or white bread.
